<p>Acceptable Items Include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Oil-based paints and varnishes Wood preservatives Cleaning solvents Pesticides and weed killers Household batteries Oven cleaners Mathalls Transmission fluid and antifreeze Pressurized cans Metallic mercury (thermometers and fluorescent bulbs) Lead (found in shot and sinkers) 	<p>Handling and Transportation of Materials:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not mix materials Do not carry loose or containers in your trunk Staff will remove the material from your trunk when you arrive at the facility You will not even need to leave your car Licensed haulers will be contracted to transport the material to be recycled, reused, or disposed of in an environmentally friendly manner <p>Items NOT Accepted:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Latex paint Used motor oil Explosives Tires Smoke detectors <p><i>Most HHW is stored in our homes, dumped in our backyards, and poured into our septic systems or lakes and streams</i></p>
