SUMMER TAX INFORMATION JULY 1st – SEPTEMBER 14th

Taxes were mailed on June 29th. If you have not received yours, please contact me at 989 834 4831. Summer taxes are due on September 14th at 5:00 p.m. After this time and date, 1% interest will be charged monthly. My hours are Monday and Thursday afternoons from 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. and Wednesday from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Checks or money orders are preferred: however, cash payments for the exact amount will be accepted.

DEFERMENT OF SUMMER TAXES:

September 14th, 2023 is the last day to file for the Summer Deferment per MCL 211.51(7).

Certain taxpayers can apply to have their summer property taxes deferred until February 14, 2024. All of the requirements and application forms may be found at www.michigan.gov/treasury.

In general, there are two ways to qualify for this deferment: 1) gross household income of \$40,000 or less and falling into the exemption classification or 2) owning an agricultural or horticultural operation for which gross receipts are not less than household income.

HALL RENTAL

Winfield Rd from Shepardsville Rd West to Gravel - Chipseal, CRS2M emulsion, slag stone & fog seal

St. Clair Rd from M-21 to Parks - Chipseal, CRS2M emulsion, slag stone & fog seal

Various local roads – 500 tons spot gravel

Parks Rd from Chandler Rd. to Watson Rd. – Placement of 1500 tons of 23a mod gravel

Parks Rd from St. Clair Rd. to Shepardsville Rd. - Placement of 1500 tons of 23a mod gravel

Parks Rd from Watson Rd. to St. Clair Rd. - Placement of 1500 tons of 23a mod gravel

Taft Rd from Chandler Rd. to Watson Rd. - Placement of 1500 tons of 23a mod gravel
