SUMMER TAX INFORMATION JULY 1st – SEPTEMBER 16th

Taxes were mailed on June 29th. If you have not received yours, please contact me at 989 834 4831. Summer taxes are due on September 14,th which falls on a Saturday so we will be accepting tax payments on Monday, September 16th with no penalty until 5:00 p.m. After this time and date, 1% interest will be charged monthly. My hours are Monday and Thursday afternoons from 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. and Wednesday from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Checks or money orders are preferred: however, cash payments for the **exact amount** will be accepted.

DEFERMENT OF SUMMER TAXES:

September 16th, 2024 is the last day to file for the Summer Deferment per MCL 211.51(7).

Certain taxpayers can apply to have their summer property taxes deferred until February 14, 2025. All of the requirements and application forms may be found at www.michigan.gov/treasury.

If you do qualify, please remember that your summer taxes must be paid by February 14, 2025 or you will be charged the interest from September 16th through February...

In general, there are two ways to qualify for this deferment: 1) gross household income of \$40,000 or less and falling into the exemption classification or 2) owning an agricultural or horticultural operation for which gross receipts are not less than household income.

HALL RENTAL

Please contact the clerk or treasurer to inquire about dates to rent the hall.

The rent is \$200 for dates May 1 – October 31 plus a \$250 deposit, which will be returned after the next board meeting if there is no cleaning, damage or other infractions listed on the contract.

For dates November 1 – April 30, the rent is \$250 plus a \$250 deposit, which will be returned after the next board meeting if there is no cleaning, damage or other infractions listed on the contract.

Access to the Hall is only on the day it is rented, unless you make arrangements to pay a \$50 Decoration Fee if you want to get in for 4 hours the night before your event.
